

Highlights

- School based VISTAs interact with and support hundreds of unique partnership organizations
- At the School District level (Arts, OSP, OCCR, OGD): COPs, data collection on partners, FAFSA completion, training on fundraising and grantwriting
- Mobilized over 5,541 volunteers
- Developed Assistant Program Coordinator/Community Partnerships position with SDP
- Eleven of our VISTA graduates working in SDP positions, 10 full-time (one as a teacher)
- PHENND VISTAs & Fellows overall generated over \$194,017 in cash and \$47,837 in non-cash resources
- Three of our graduated schools became MOE community schools
