SAT Prep Program Information

- The College Board has partnered with Khan Academy to create an online SAT prep tutorial.
- We have 2 student coordinators and 10 volunteers
- Our BMC volunteers guide and coach Parkway West High School Juniors and Seniors through the tutorial.
- The program culminates in a fulllength practice SAT at BMC₁
 followed by a campus tour and lunch BRYN MAV

SAT Prep Volunteer Training

- 2 sessions
- College Board staff led one session
 - -SAT/Khan Academy Overview
 - -SAT changes
 - College Board & Khan resources
- Student coordinators led session on our specific program requirements
 - -General expectations of volunteers
 - -Role Play scenarios

Typical SAT Prep Session

- One-on-one coaching through Khan Academy SAT Tutorial
- Individualized online program
 - -This involves practicing questions watching videos reading hints etc.
- Mentoring



SAT Prep- Next Steps

- Expand to semester long programs in Fall and Spring
- Seniors in the fall Juniors in the spring
- Working with the school guidance counselor to increase enrollment in the program
