Requirements

- All ESOL Tutor candidates must have at least 60 university credits
- Fluency in another language, while not required, is preferred

Essential Functions & Commitments

- Tutors will work with ELL identified District students. They will be assigned a cooperating teacher/school resource person at each location and will work closely with a Multilingual Manager from the Office of Multilingual Curriculum and Programs (OMCP)
- Tutors are hourly employees paid at the rate of at least \$12/hour with no benefits and must commit to 6-25 hours/week consistently on a weekly schedule for the duration of the placement, following the school district calendar for this program

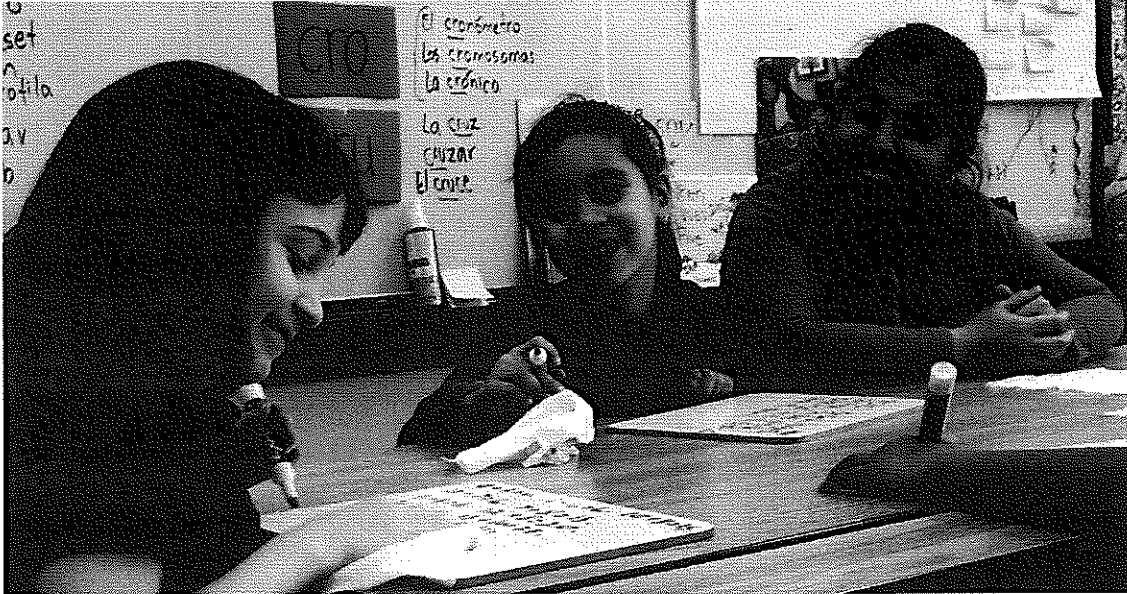
Applications will be accepted on a continuous basis until the needs of the District are met.
